


## MizuPhone Configuration Guide

After downloading MizuPhone, follow instructions below:

For Username, you can use whatever you want since this is just for profile and configuration purposes. Take note, that this part has nothing to do with your SIP Username and SIP Password.



Password is your SIP Password.

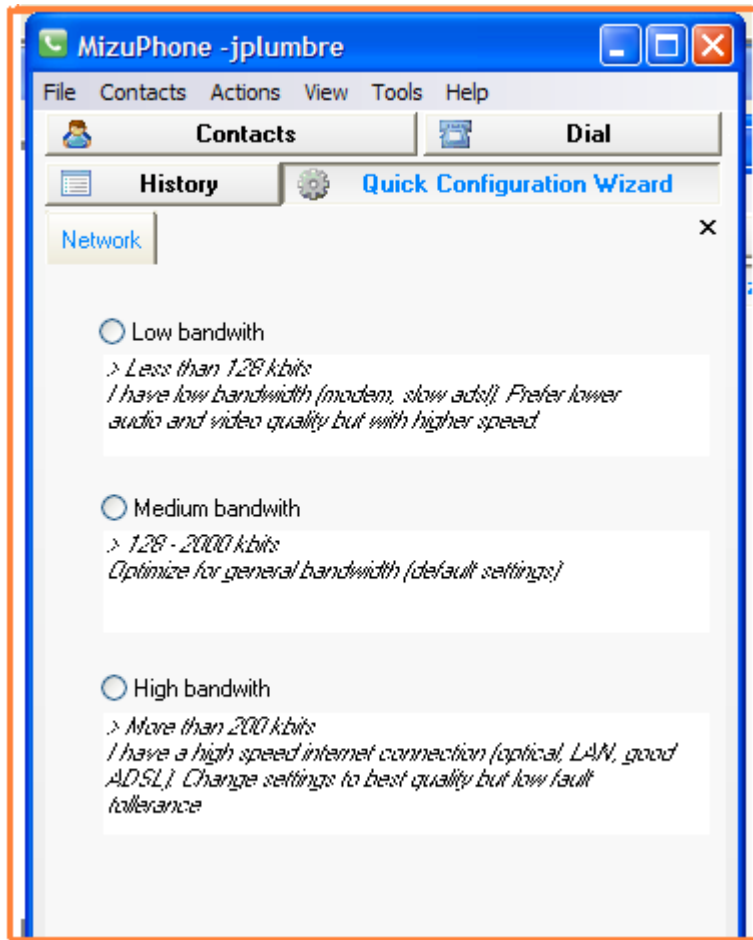

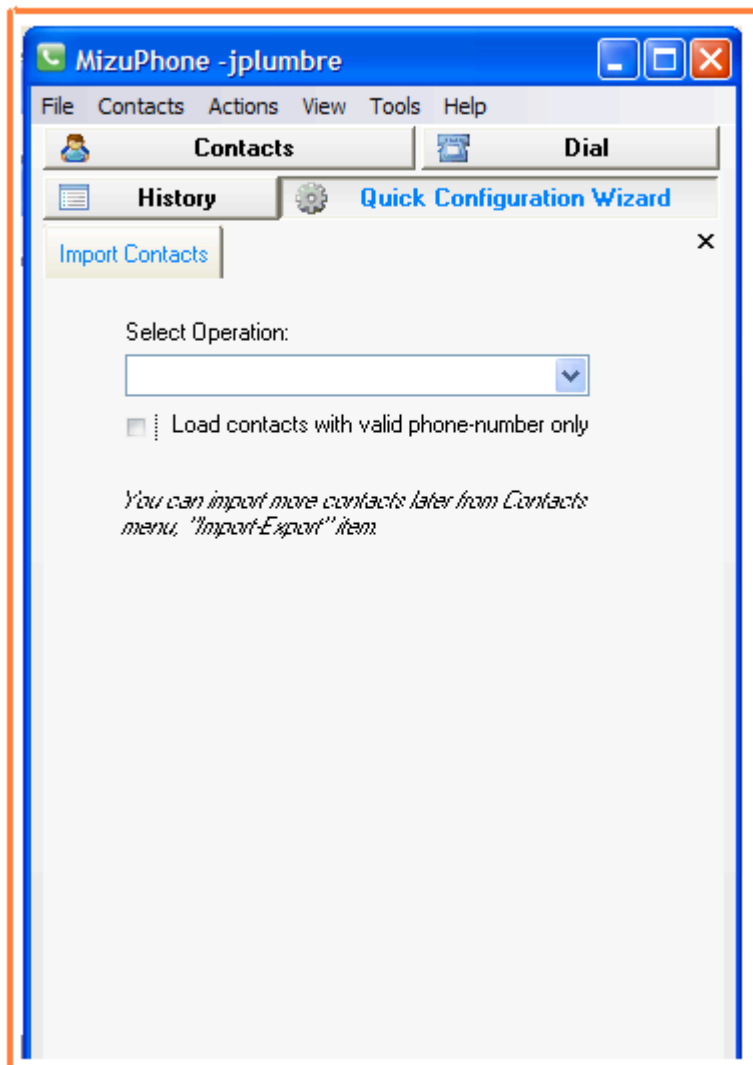
